Payments must be received in **FULL** the Friday before the first day of each camp session via our website or you may write a check or money order payable to DramaSmarts and mail it 24960 Center Ridge Road, Westlake, Ohio 44145. Please include \$12 per day for early drop off between 7:30-9:00 A.M. and \$16 per day for late pick-up between 3:00-6:00 P.M. Also, please include full payment for each child that you register.

**DramaSmarts Theater & Art Camp 2013** will start on Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 A.M. and continue each day from **7:30 A.M.-6:00 P.M.** ending Friday, July 26. The camp will be closed July 4<sup>th</sup> and July 5<sup>th</sup>.

All field trips must be registered for one-week prior and paid for in full. Students must wear their DramaSmarts t-shirts on the day of all fieldtrips. Field trip list will be sent home on the first day of camp for the 2, 4, and 7-week camps. If your child is not registered for a field trip one week in advance they will be allowed to attend. DramaSmarts will depart at the scheduled time for all field trips and no staff member will remain on site during field trips.

Please make sure to review the registration checklist prior to sumitting your child's application.

### **ART CAMP**

Does your child enjoy art? Do they like using old things to make new creations? If so, this 1-week camp will teach your child how to make new stuff out of old things and also teach them about recycling using materials found right at home. Students will do things like, create robots out of old cans, use recycled milk and orange juice cartons to make clever carrying cases for change, trading cards, and more. A final art showcase will take place for family and friends to view the student's work from the week. No formal art experience is necessary. Supplies included.
